Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDO) Brevard County Housing and Human Services Department (BCHHS)

WHAT IS A COMMUNITY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION?

A CHDO (pronounced cho'doe) is a private nonprofit, community-based service organization that has significant organizational capacity with a **primary** purpose to develop affordable housing for the community it serves. Certified CHDOs receive special designation and certification from the Brevard County Housing and Human Services Department (BCHHS). The Federal HOME Program definition of a CHDO is found at the Code of Federal Regulations, 24 CFR Part 92.208, 300 and 301. (See HUD CHDO information links below)

WHAT SPECIAL BENEFITS ARE AVAILABLE TO CHDOS?

Federal HOME regulations require that BCHHS set aside 15 percent of its annual HOME funding allocation exclusively for qualified, eligible CHDO projects. If an organization becomes a certified CHDO, it is eligible to take advantage of the HUD HOME funds set-aside just for CHDOs, participate in the request for proposal process administered by the County, and potentially qualify for CHDO status with the State of Florida.
