

BREVARD COUNTY HOUSING AND HUMAN SERVICES CORONAVIRUS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Brevard County received \$105 million on April 23, 2020 from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). On May 5, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved up to \$4.4 million for a Rental and Mortgage Assistance Program, Utility and Security Deposit Program, and a Food Stability Program.

Program Overview:

1. There **must** be a connection to coronavirus (COVID-19).
 - a. Must submit information proving the connection.
2. Cannot be above 140% of Area Median Income (AMI) for the household size (\$96,880 for a family of four).
3. Maximum of assistance in the amount of \$12,500.
4. The applicant **must** sign all required documents (application, social security number waiver, release/request of information, etc.) or their application will be rejected/denied.
5. All members of a household must be accounted for in the application.
6. If they are filling out the application by hand, please make sure that their writing is clear and legible.
7. Applications will be available at multiple locations:
 - a. By mail.
 - b. By email at BrevardCaresAct2020@brevardfl.gov, if requested.
 - c. Download from the Brevard County Housing and Human Service Department's website.
 - d. At all County Libraries.
 - e. On County buses (all routes).
