# Paper Plate Jellyfish



## Supplies in Bag

Paper plate, googly eyes, ribbon/string, and tissue paper.

## Home Supplies

Glue or tape, crayons/markers, scissors, and a hole punch.

## Directions:

This activity is intended for you to do at home with your family.

1. Decide which side of your plate will be the top and which will be the bottom.
2. Cut a wavy line across the bottom of your plate.
3. Use your hole punch to make several holes in the bottom of your plate.
4. Thread pieces of ribbon or string through the holes and tie a knot. These will be the tentacles.
5. Glue tissue paper strip along the bottom of your plate (on the back side).
6. Color and decorate the front of your plate. Draw a mouth for your jellyfish.
7. Glue eyes to the plate.
