DIY T-Shirt Dog Toy



Supplies Provided

Instructions

Home Supplies

Two old t-shirts or towels and scissors. Optional: sewing needle and thread.

Directions:

This activity is intended for you to do at home with your family.

1. Cut your shirts into long strips.
2. Gather several strips together and tie a large knot at one end.
3. Braid or knot the strips together until you reach the end of the strips.
4. Tie the bottom of the strips together to form a knot.
5. Pull tightly on your knots to secure them!
6. Optional: use a sewing needle and thread to sew a few stitches into the knots at the ends of your dog toy.
7. Extension Activity: Make and distribute toys to an animal shelter!
