We are shaking things up a bit with our Summer Reading Program 2021!

In this week's Storytime Packet, our theme is the Jungle! Travel with us and discover some suggested reads, rhymes, fingerplays, and crafts centered around rainforests and jungles.

All suggested reads can be found in the Brevard County Public Library System and are available to be checked out.

This packet consists of two fully developed storytimes: Babies & Toddlers, and Preschool. Each storytime can be used for all ages though and are for early literacy enrichment and education at home.

Why storytime?

- Literacy development starts early in life and is highly correlated with school achievement.
- Reading and storytelling with your child promotes brain development and imagination, teaches your child about language and emotions, and strengthens your relationship.
- You don't always need to read books! Try looking at picture books, singing rhymes and songs, or telling stories from your culture.

Jungle Storytime

Babies & Toddlers

Suggested Books:

Lapsit: Funky Spunky Monkey (tune: Itsy Bitsy Spider)

The funky spunky monkey climbed up the coconut tree *(climbing motion)*

Down came a coconut and bonked him on his knee (wave hand down and slap knee)

Along came his mama and kissed away his pain (blow a kiss)

And the funky spunky monkey climbed up the tree again *(climbing motion)*

Fingerplay: Two Little Toucans

(Similar to Two Little Blackbirds)

Two little toucans sitting in a tree (Hold up index fingers)

One named Lulu, one named Lee. (Wiggle each index finger)

Fly away, Lulu! Fly away, Lee! (Hide fingers behind back)

Come back, Lulu! Come back, Lee! (Hold up fingers again)

Song: "All the Babies Like Bananas"



(Pretend to be the animal as you "wash" each part of yourself)
