Paper Plate Fox



Supplies in Bag

Paper plate, cardstock, and one black pom-pom.

Home Supplies

Scissors, Glue and markers or paint.

Directions:

This activity is intended for you to do at home with your family.

- 1. Color or paint the inside of the paper plate the main color you'd like your fox to be.
- 2. Fold over the edges of the plate with one end forming a point, and the other making a V shape.
- 3. Glue down the folds you made in step 2.
- 4. On the pointed end of the paper plate, glue on a black pom-pom to make the nose.
- 5. Give your fox eyes.
- 6. On a piece of cardstock, draw and color two pointy ears.
- 7. Cut out the ears you made in step 6, then glue to the back of the plate to complete your fox.
