Eau Gallie Library

Jenny re-introduced Lauren Biller, the new Reference Supervisor. Lauren will be in charge of the building after Jenny's retirement if a new director has not been selected.

E.G.P.L. is doing a lot of hiring. We have a new staff member in Circulation, Bonnie Crawford. Bonnie is replacing Katharine Argall who is now in a hybrid position (Reference and Y.S.).

We have identified a candidate for Linda Cruey's position (part-time). Jenny is unable to hire her until the new salary increases are put into the system.

Patrick Maier, who worked in the Reference area, accepted a position at the C.S. Rood Central Library as head of their Reference Department. It is a promotion for Patrick.

Our air handler, which has been an ongoing issue, has been pushed out until next year.

Although the budget for F.Y. 21-22 has not been approved yet, Jenny said looking at the it she thinks there will be enough money to paint the interior of the library.

Programs: Hispanic Heritage Month is something new the libraries are celebrating and E.G.P.L. picked Bolivia as their country to highlight.

The library has two programs planned: A Latin inspired ukulele program on October 16, 2021 from 10-11 A.M. And a weaving presentation by the Space Coast Weavers Guild on October 2, 2021 from 10 A.M. to 4 P.M.

Jenny thanked the board for all the support and help they have given to her and the library over the past 12 years. She said it has been a pleasure to work with the board.

Melbourne Public Library

Irma said the Melbourne Library is also doing a lot of hiring as they 5 open positions.
