The term "undue hardship" has a specific legal definition in his context and essentially means that without the requested variance, the applicant will have be reasonable use of the subject property under existing development regulations. Personal hedical reasons shall not be considered as grounds for establishing undue hardship sufficient of qualify an applicant for a variance. Economic reasons may be considered only in instances where a landowner cannot yield a reasonable use and/or reasonable return under the existing and development regulations. You have the right to consult a private attorney for assistance. It order to authorize any variance from the terms of this chapter, the Board of Adjustment shall and all of the following factors to exist: 1. That special conditions and circumstances exist which are not applicable to other lands, structures, or buildings in the applicable zoning classification.
