## SPECIAL WASTES--require pre-disposal approval

- Asbestos
- Animal carcasses
- Containers >20 gallons
- Petroleum Contaminated Soil
- Sludge
- Treated Biomedical Waste

## PROHIBITED WASTES

- Ammunition, flares, etc.
- Batteries (Auto, lithium, rechargeable)
- CRTs (TVs, Monitors)-Commercial
- Electronics/Brown Goods
- Fluorescent Lamps-Commercial
- Hazardous Waste
- Liquid waste
- Mercury Containing Devices
- Motor Vehicles
- PCB wastes
- Pressurized cylinders
- Propane tanks
- Sharps (needles, lancets, etc.)\*\*
- Untreated Biomedical Waste

\* Treated Wood (CCA) is wood treated with chemicals to protect the wood from rotting due to insects and microbial agents (typically includes decks, docks, fences, playground and landscaping timbers, utility poles and railroad ties).

\*\* Homeuser sharps accepted at the CDF HHWCC.
