

VALKARIA AIRPORT SUMMARY

MISSION STATEMENT:

To provide a safe and secure airport, twenty-four hours per day/seven days per week, both airside and landside. To provide a pilot briefing area, aviation fuel, hangar space, tie downs, retail merchandise and other ancillary services to meet the demands of airport users while, at the same time, reducing current operating expenses.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES:

ACCOMPLISHMENTS, INITIATIVES, TRENDS AND ISSUES AND SERVICE LEVEL IMPACTS:

VALKARIA AIRPORT:

- Valkaria Airport provides operational oversight of four runways, associated taxiways, parking areas, tie downs and ninety-five hangar units
- The airport provides land and facilities for the Habitat golf course and southern Brevard County Mosquito Control
- Unicom and Common Traffic Advisory Frequency, Universal Communications, Airport Radio Advisories, Notice to Airmen (N O T A M) postings, and supports an Airport Weather Observation (A W O S -II)
- The Airport provides routine maintenance on various fixed navigational equipment; Precision Approach Path Indicators (P A P I), Runway Edge Lights, Runway Threshold Lights and Airport Communications Equipment
- Valkaria airport provides routine maintenance of runways and taxiways and other facilities funded through Charges for services.
- Capital Improvements Projects are funded through grants received from the Federal Aviation (F A A) and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) with matching funds generated from airport revenues
- Continuous implementation of capital improvement projects outlined in the Airport Master Plan as approved by the Board of County Commissioners, funded through airport revenues and grants

Accomplishments:

- Completed construction of General Aviation Terminal & Administration Office
- Acquired five-acre property next to Runway 14/32
- Completed construction Hangar-F Complex
- Completed construction of Primary Runway 14-32
- Completed construction of Electrical Vault
- Completed construction of Pole Barn

Initiatives:

- Construction projects in various stages as highlighted below

Trends and Issues:

The operation and growth are outlined in the Airport Master Plan (A M P). Continuing projects and projects planned to start in Fiscal Year 2021 are as follows:

- Construct all new airport security access system
- Develop and implement R N A V Instrument Approach Procedures
- Design Hangar G Complex and possible Shade hangars facility
- Construction Taxiway A expansion and lighting
- 10% Forecasted Fuel sales reduction due to COVID-19
- 100 L L Fuel Tank replacement through F D O T Grant funds
